COMPULSORY PREPARATORY PROGRAM PROFICIENCY EXAM

Foreign language exemption exam for students newly enrolled in programs where the language of instruction is entirely or partially English (including international students) and students who failed the preparatory education the previous year will be held in person on Thursday, September 11, 2025, at 10:00 AM at the School of Foreign Languages on the Batı Raman Campus. The School of Foreign Languages is located in Building E of the Faculty of Science and Arts at Batı Raman Campus.

Students who will receive preparatory education must take this exam. Students who do not take this exam cannot be exempted from preparatory education. (Except for students covered by Article 13, Paragraph 6, Section B of our University's Foreign Languages School Regulations)

Students who will take the exemption exam do not need to register for the exam at our School.

Exemption Exam will be held on Thursday, September 11, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. at the School of Foreign Languages, Batman University, Batı Raman Campus. Students who are newly enrolled in departments/programs where the language of instruction is entirely or partially English and who failed English in the preparatory class in the previous academic year will take this exam.

The exam, which will be conducted in English, will consist of two sessions. The morning session will consist of multiple-choice questions (grammar, vocabulary, and reading comprehension), listening comprehension, and essay writing. The afternoon session will consist of a speaking section. The exam duration is 120 minutes. The speaking exam is not included in this time.

Please read the following exam information carefully.

Exam Information

Candidates must bring a "Photo ID Card" (Turkish ID card, driver's license, or passport) with them when entering the exam. No "exam admission document" will be required at the exam entrance.

The exam duration is 120 minutes (excluding the Speaking section).

Only correct answers will be taken into account during the evaluation.

Candidates must be present at the Foreign Languages School 30 minutes before the exam start time. Since pencils, erasers, etc. will not be distributed during the exam, candidates must bring these necessary items with them.

Candidates arriving after the first 40 minutes of the exam will not be admitted. Candidates cannot leave the exam room during the first 60 minutes of the exam.

Candidates are prohibited from using cell phones, smart watches, and similar devices in the exam room. Candidates found with electronic devices, whether open or closed, during the exam will be accused of cheating and their exam will be invalidated.

It is the responsibility of candidates to follow the announcements and take the exam on the specified date and time.
